Types of Pool







Concrete pools offer unparalleled durability and customisation. Concrete allows for any shape or depth, making it ideal for designs that require a bespoke approach, whether that's integrating complex features like vanishing edges, custom tiling, or unique pool shapes.

The construction involves steel—reinforced structures filled with gunite or shotcrete, topped with a finish of your choice, such as plaster, aggregate, or tile. Although the construction period can be slightly longer, the end product is a robust and timeless addition to your home.

Vinyl-lined pools are a cost-effective and versatile choice that allows for considerable customisation without the higher price tag of concrete pools. These pools consist of prefabricated supporting frames that are then lined with a heavy-duty vinyl covering.

The liners are available in a variety of designs and colours, allowing for aesthetic flexibility to match any garden theme. However, liners can be susceptible to damage from sharp objects and will typically require replacement every 5 to 9 years, depending on usage and care.

Stainless steel pools offer a modern and sophisticated option that is both durable and sleek. These pools are built using panels of stainless steel that are assembled onsite, offering a high degree of resistance to corrosion and staining. The reflective properties of the metal add a luminous quality to the water, enhancing the aesthetic appeal of the pool.

Stainless steel is particularly suitable for indoor pools. Though typically more expensive upfront, the longevity and low maintenance requirements can provide good value over time.

Indoor or Outdoor?



Indoor pools are an excellent choice for year-round swimming, regardless of the weather. They offer:

- **Climate Control:** You have complete control over the environment, including temperature and humidity, making swimming comfortable in all seasons.
- Privacy and Security: Indoor pools provide maximum privacy and are secure from external access.
- **Reduced Maintenance:** There are no leaves or debris to clean up, and the chemical balance of the water is more stable without the effects of rain and sun.
- **Health and Fitness:** An indoor pool can easily become part of your fitness routine, especially appealing if you're looking to enhance your wellness in the privacy of your home.

Location



Sunlight and Shade: A sunny spot can help keep the pool water naturally warm, reducing heating costs. However, you may prefer partial shade to ensure the area remains usable and comfortable throughout the day, especially in the hottest months. We can help design the location of your pool to optimise sun exposure or provide solutions such as pergolas or strategically planted trees for natural shade.



Proximity to House: Convenience and accessibility are key. It should be easily accessible from the house but positioned to minimise noise when the pool is in use. Safety is important; it's essential to have a clear line of sight to the pool to monitor children or guests. Additionally, considerations around existing structures are vital to avoid issues with overhanging trees, buried utilities, or septic systems.



Privacy: Your pool should be a private retreat, away from prying eyes. We consider surrounding structures, fencing, and natural features that can enhance the seclusion of your pool area. If natural barriers are not sufficient, we can recommend privacy screens or landscape designs that increase seclusion.



Wind Exposure: Wind can cool pool water and lead to increased evaporation and debris in the pool. We consider the prevailing winds and recommend strategic placements of barriers such as walls, fences, or vegetation to block or redirect winds, ensuring a calm and clean pool environment.




Topography and Drainage: The natural slope of your plot can influence the design and placement of your pool. A slope can be utilised for an infinity edge where appropriate or may necessitate specific engineering solutions to ensure proper drainage and structural integrity. Effective drainage is crucial to prevent flooding and soil erosion around the pool area.















Size & Shape



Space Availability: It's important to maintain a balance, ensuring there's enough room around the pool for movement, furniture, and landscaping.



User Capacity: If you enjoy hosting parties, you may prefer a larger pool, while smaller pools may suffice for private relaxation or fitness.



Budget: The size of the pool directly impacts the cost – not just for initial construction but also for ongoing maintenance and heating.



Purpose: The intended use of the pool will also dictate the size and shape. Lap pools are typically longer and narrower, while play pools will have greater shallow areas. Circular or kidney-shaped pools are excellent for social interactions.



Architectural Harmony: The shape of your pool should complement the style of your home. For modern homes, geometric shapes like rectangles or L-shapes are perfect, while organic, curved shapes can blend beautifully with more traditional settings.



Landscape Integration: The shape of the pool can also enhance or integrate with the existing landscape. Curved pools can flow with natural contours, and infinity edges can extend sight lines to nearby scenic views.

The size and shape of your pool are not just practical considerations but also important elements of design that affect the aesthetics and enjoyment of your outdoor space.

We work closely with you to choose dimensions and contours that meet your needs, fit your landscape, and reflect your style, ensuring that your pool is both a personal retreat and a perfect gathering place.

Style and Aesthetics

The design of your pool should be a natural extension of your home's architecture and your personal design preferences.

For **contemporary homes**, you may prefer clean lines and minimalist designs.

Geometric shapes such as rectangles or squares, sleek materials like glass tiles, stainless steel or polished stone and features such as infinity edges can look superb in a modern design.

For historic or traditional homes, curved lines, Roman ends and materials such as natural stone or classic mosaic tiles can enhance the home's period feel.

Lighting can also play a key role with underwater LED lights or elegant poolside lanterns enhancing the ambience.

If the pool is to be centre of activity for children and guests, incorporating a slide or diving board can make the pool area more engaging and fun.





For a tranquil space, using natural stone, water features and lush landscaping will create a serene retreat.

Positioning the pool to capture scenic views or creating a visual connection with part of the garden will make swimming and relaxing by the pool more pleasurable.

A smooth transition from house to pool enhances the usability and aesthetic flow. We achieve this by using complementary

flooring materials and colour palettes.

Finishing touches such as the choice of natural stone or decking and coping can dramatically affect the look and feel of the pool.

Heating Options



Gas/Oil Heaters: Highly efficient for short periods and can maintain water temperature regardless of air temperature.



Electric Heaters: Similar to gas/oil heaters, electric heaters are effective at heating pool water quickly.

Advantages: Fast heating time makes this option ideal for pools that aren't used daily but need quick heating.

Advantages: Simple and reliable, electric heaters are effective regardless of outside temperature and are compact, making them suitable for small pools.

Considerations: Operational costs can be high and less environmentally friendly compared to solar or heat pump systems.

Considerations: Less energy-efficient than heat pumps however we have used these in conjunction with solar heating to utilise spare energy to heat the pool, rather than sending it back to the grid.



Heat pumps: These extract heat from the surrounding air or ground and transfer it to the pool water.



Solar: This involves panels that absorb heat and transfer it to the pool water via a circulating pump.

Advantages: More energy-efficient than fossil fuels and can provide significant cost savings over time. They operate quietly and are particularly efficient in the warmer months.

Advantages: Eco-friendly and cost-effective in the long run, solar heaters have minimal operational costs after installation.

Considerations: Higher initial investment than gas/oil heaters. The efficiency drops as the air temperature falls, so may need to be supplemented with other heating options.

Considerations: Requires significant upfront investment and adequate space for panel installation. Solar heating is dependent on significant sunlight, so it's likely to need supplemental heating with another heating type of heating system.

Safety Features

Pool Covers: These not only keep your pool clean but also add an important layer of safety.

Automatic covers that can support the weight of children and pets ensure that even if they wander onto the cover, they won't fall through.

Solar covers and thermal blankets also help in maintaining water temperature. A robust pool cover minimises evaporation, keeps debris out, and ensures that when the pool is not in use, it remains inaccessible to children and animals.

Alarms: These are essential in households with young children or pets. They immediately notify you of any unexpected entry into the pool water.

We install surface wave detection alarms and subsurface disturbance sensors that activate when someone enters the pool area.

Steps/Handrails: For ease of access and security, particularly for children, the elderly or those with mobility issues. We incorporate steps and handrails into our designs.







Design and Build Process



Consultation: Each project begins with a comprehensive consultation to understand your vision and specific needs. We discuss:

- Design preferences and lifestyle needs.
- Functional requirements size & desired features.
- Budget aligning design choices with your budget.
- Site evaluation assessing layout, sunlight, weather patterns and regulatory requirements.



Design: We then create customised plans focusing on:

- Integrating the design with your home's architecture and natural landscape.
- Details such as pool features and selecting the finishes and materials.



Construction: Our meticulous construction includes:

- Preparation site clearing, access setup, excavation.
- Build using high–quality materials appropriate with the pool type and ensuring structural integrity.
- Plumbing & Electrical skilled engineers ensure all components comply with legal regulations.
- Surfacing & Finishing interior finishing with selected materials and surrounding area installed with chosen coping, paving/decking.
- Testing filtration, heating and lighting are thoroughly tested.



Post-build support:

- Handover upon completion we conduct a detailed walk-through, including care instructions and warranties for our workmanship.
